

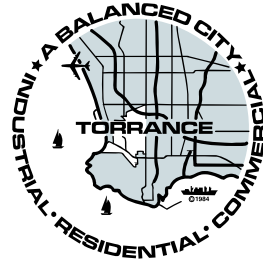
## The City

Located in Los Angeles County's South Bay, Torrance borders the Pacific Ocean and beach communities to the west and the Palos Verdes peninsula to the south. Ideally situated near the 405 (San Diego) freeway and 20 minutes from the Los Angeles International Airport, Torrance occupies 21 square miles, including a beachfront and the Madrona Marsh, a fresh-water habitat. Torrance is within a 45-minute drive of many major Southern California attractions.

Incorporated in 1921 and chartered in 1947, Torrance has a population of nearly 147,000 and is the 12th largest city in California. Torrance is a full-service city with an annual budget in excess of \$200 million and a staff of over 1600 in 14 departments. The City has a council-manager form of government with an elected mayor and six council members.

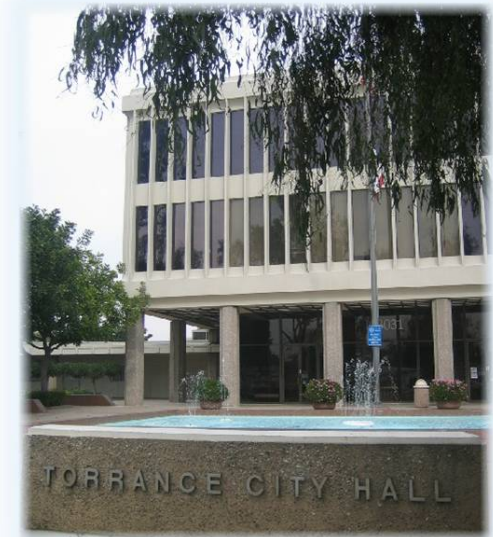
The area enjoys a pleasant year-round climate with warm temperatures, gentle sea breezes and low humidity. The City boasts 46 parks and recreation amenities and six public libraries. The 502-seat James Armstrong Theatre in the Torrance Cultural Arts Center is an excellent venue for professional and local productions.

The community's population is culturally rich with an estimate of more than 80 languages spoken in local schools. Contributing to this diversity are such world-class international companies as Toyota Motor Sales U.S.A., American Honda Motor Company, Hi-Shear Corporation, Robinson Helicopter, Honeywell, Panasonic, and Virco Manufacturing, each of which call Torrance Home. Four major shopping centers are located in Torrance, including Del Amo Fashion Center, one of the largest shopping centers in the world.

## TRAFFIC & LIGHTING SUPERVISOR (JC 09105533) Re-Issue

The City of Torrance seeks a dedicated and results driven individual to serve as the Traffic & Lighting Supervisor. The position supervises the installation and maintenance of the City's traffic signals, street signs, street/pavement markings, and outdoor overhead lighting systems; responsible for the installation, maintenance and repair of traffic control devices such as signals, signs, pavement markings and outdoor overhead lighting; assists with the design of traffic signals and street/pavement markings; inspection of traffic signals, signs and marking installations; and manages assigned resources. Performs related work as required.

The **ideal** candidate will demonstrate:

- **Strong technical experience in electrical and electronics;**
- **Public sector experience with paint, signage usage and outdoor lighting;**
- **Good recordkeeping and documentation skills;**
- **Good understanding of OSHA guidelines, safety procedures, rules and regulations;**
- **Effective communications skills both verbal and written;**
- **Good interpersonal skills;**
- **The ability to read, understand and interpret specifications, diagrams, and schematics;**
- **The ability to work independently, be proactive in developing traffic and lighting programs and contribute to future development with those programs.**

## Minimum Requirements

### Experience:

High School Graduation or equivalent; and a Vocational/Technical degree or certificate with an emphasis in traffic engineering, traffic control and signal devices; supplemented by five (5) years of progressively responsible experience in traffic control installation, repair and maintenance work; or any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience.

### Special:

A valid class C California Drivers License is required. A Level 1 or 2 International Municipal Signal Association Traffic Signal Certification is desirable. **Ability to respond to emergency situations during non-working hours is required.**

## Selection Process

Applications and questionnaire response will be reviewed. Only those candidates who are found to be **most qualified** will be invited to participate in the examination.

The examination will consist of a computerized or video based supervisory assessment (weighted 50%) **tentatively scheduled for January 6, 2010.** Those candidates who successfully complete the assessment portion will be invited to the technically oral interview (weighted 50%) **tentatively scheduled for January 28, 2010.**

## Special Notes

The City of Torrance Conflict of Interest Code requires that employees in this classification file an annual Financial Disclosure Statement. Information about this requirement may be obtained from the City Clerk's office.

As a condition of employment, candidates must pass a background check and pre-employment medical examination.
