

Competition Team Fundraising

Competition team members are required to participate in all Torrettes fundraisers. The funds raised are used to offset the costs of the competitions that we participate in each year, including Show Stoppers in the spring. We have estimated that each competition team member will be required to raise \$100.00. Failure to complete your fundraising commitment will result in being benched from Show Stoppers and/or the Spring Spectacular. The following opportunities will be available to you for fundraising:

Kick-A-Thon

Competition team members are required to obtain pledges for the annual kick-a-thon and to bring bake sale items that will be either auctioned off during the bake sale or used as prizes for the cake walk. Brownies and themed (Halloween) items have been the best sellers.

Recycling

Take your aluminum cans and plastic bottles to your local recycling location and turn them in for the CRV and bring the money back to your directors to be credited to your account. You can watch your totals grow on the recycling posters every Wednesday at full team practices! All Torrettes who recycle \$50.00 by the end of the year will be invited to an ice cream social to celebrate your achievement.

Winter Show

Competition team members are required to donate or solicit a donated item to be raffled at the Winter Show.

Spring Spectacular Program Ads

Competition team members are required to sell at least one (1) program ad for the Spring Spectacular. This is a great opportunity for our community merchants to reach over 300 people at one event. Program and sale flyers will be distributed in April.

Corporate Sponsors

This year we are soliciting corporate sponsorships. Any sponsorship that you bring to the team will be credited towards your competition costs. There are three (3) different sponsorship levels.
